16-060 - Resolution E-406 - Postage Machine Lease

The current postage machine lease has expired. This lease from Pitney Bowes is from the Washington State purchasing contract and will be in effect for five years. The new machine has the ability to track postage by department and complies with all federal postal regulations. Maintenance is included in the quarterly payment of \$424.98.

16-061 - Resolution E-407 - Laminate Pole Purchase

The Light Department needs to purchase a laminate pole for the 2016 Murphy and Betz Road Line Move Project. The pole can be purchased from McFarland Cascade for the purchase price of \$13,455.00 plus tax.
