16-079 - Resolution E-424 - Third Party Building Plan Review Services Contract

A Request for Proposals was advertised for building plan review services. City staff has reviewed the proposals and recommends entering into a contract with CWA Consultants for third party building plan review services.

16-078 - Ordinance W-94 - 2016 Budget Amendment #2

This is the 2nd budget amendment of 2016 and covers ten (10) funds totaling \$523,300. The proposed amendments are as follows: General Fund - \$3,500, Street Fund - \$12,000, Residential Street Fund - \$40,000, Park Capital Reserve - \$140,000, Police Equipment Fund - \$5,000, Criminal Justice Fund - \$28,000, Parks and Recreation Fund - \$14,000, Light Fund - \$51,400, Water Fund - \$207,800, and the Sewer Fund - \$21,600.
