

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

November 1, 2016

Mayor Trulove called the Special City Council meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. at the Utility Building, 112 Anderson Road.

Councilmembers present included Councilmember Overhauser, Councilmember Nixon, Councilmember Grover, Councilmember Weismann, Councilmember Gaard, and Councilmember Hilton. Staff members present were Mr. Schuller, Ms. Niemeier, Mr. Ableman, Mr. Billigmeier, Ms. Cooper, and Mr. Hensley.

Mayor Trulove discussed delivering our services at the lowest cost to our citizens. Mr. Schuller spoke about discretionary requests. Mr. Billigmeier discussed the small bucket truck, power quality meter, thermal camera, and underground pulling equipment. Mr. Ableman discussed the need to replace the curbtender garbage truck. He explained the preventative maintenance schedule and stated that the current truck would be used as a backup. Department heads discussed other discretionary requests, including council iPads, fire station improvements, fire truck needs and financing, court victim advocate, unfunded police needs, fire volunteers, and water and sewer needs. Mayor Trulove talked about a quiet zone. Councilmember Grover asked about building reserves.
